Main activity

- Using the accompanying PowerPoint, show students the task slide.
- Using the task sheet, ask students to research business apprenticeships and full-time university business degrees. They should create a list of benefits for each and consider the areas on the slide.
- Ask students to share what they have found.

Reflection task

• Ask students how they now feel about their future learning and employment options and if they have some new possibilities to consider.

Home Learning
