COMPARING DIFFERENT LANGUAGES

Main activity

- Using the accompanying PowerPoint, look at the phrases in the turquoise speech bubbles, translate them into the language you are teaching and add the translation to the pink speech bubbles. Make sure they are jumbled up so for example, 1 = D, 2 = A
- Ask students to match up the phrases using the accompanying Student Worksheet. They could write 1-5 then put the letter for the corresponding speech bubble.
- Ask the students what they think the speech bubbles are about.....the answer is apprenticeships!

Reflection task

• Encourage students to discuss the target language. Are any words similar to the English translation? Are there any big differences?

Home Learning
