

National Apprenticeship Week 'Teacher Talk' film

A five-step guide to your breaktime film showing

Thank you for setting up a Teacher Talk as part of National Apprenticeship Week 2020. To help support your upcoming talk, we've created an easy five-step guide.

Step 1: Introduction

Welcome your colleagues and make sure everyone has a cup of tea or coffee. Tell them why you've chosen to hold a film showing this National Apprenticeship Week and let them know you'll only need 10 minutes of their time (5 minutes to show film and 5 minutes for discussion).

Step 2: Play the film

Use a laptop or projector to play the short film, "20 things you need to know about apprenticeships in 2020". You can download the film from Monday 27th January 2020: amazingapprenticeships.com/naw2020



Step 3: Time to talk apprenticeships!

You may find there are already questions and discussions going on. We've put together some key talking points raised in the film for you to discuss with your colleagues.

- What more could we do to encourage students to consider apprenticeships?
- Do we need any extra support or resources to help inform students of apprenticeship options?
- Do our students understand the apprenticeship option as well as the full-time university option for their future?

Step 4: Next steps

Now you have your colleagues' attention, what are the next steps you could take to keep the conversation going?

- Discuss to see if there are any actions you can take forward? E.g. holding a lunch time club to talk about apprenticeship options with Year 11s / setting up an apprenticeship information display board.
