Explore these five engaging ideas for using the Amazing Apprenticeships resources with your students to spark interest and debate.

25 INSPIRATIONAL CASE STUDIES

From Assistant Data Scientist to Zookeeper – the A-Z features 25 inspirational case studies of male apprentices in a diverse range of job roles. Encourage your students to read these case studies. What did they find surprising? Which job roles interest them most?

WHICH MALE ROLE MODEL INSPIRES YOU?

For each of the apprentice case studies, we have asked them to identify which male role model inspires them and why. Discuss with your students which male role model they would select and to describe what they find inspirational about them.

CREATE YOUR OWN INSPIRATIONAL QUOTE

Each of our apprentices has created their own inspirational quote to share with others. Ask your students to create their own quote. Display these around the school to inspire your students and staff.

DISCUSS THE DIFFERENCE

There are still a number of job roles that are dominated by particular genders. For example, construction or nursing. Create a classroom debate about why this is and what could be done to address the imbalance.
