- Sport and fitness and Adventurous Training

WHAT YOU NEED TO JOIN

EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW.

- Minimum age to apply: 15 years and 7 months
- Entry requirements: Depends on the role you want in the Army once you've completed your training. See the role finder: apply.army.mod.uk/roles
- Course length: 23 or 49 weeks (including holidays) depending on your role



- Pay: About £950 per month (food and accommodation paid for) rising to £1,450 per month after 6 months.
- Sport facilities: Large gym, 25-metre swimming pool, indoor climbing wall, basketball courts, football and rugby pitchest.
- Other facilities: Snack shop on site and a club where you can get food, watch films, use the internet and hang out with other Junior Soldiers.
- What's next? Specialist training for your chosen role.
