As a Health and Safety Apprentice, my journey has been a unique and enriching experience that has provided me with valuable insights into the world of occupational health and safety. My job involves a wide variety of tasks and responsibilities on a daily basis. Work I have completed includes; writing risk assessments, developing safety procedures, creating a legal compliance register, supporting construction projects to ensure they comply with CDM regulations, completing occupational health surveys, and undertaking incident investigations. I have also actively participated in workplace inspections, accompanying seasoned safety professionals to inspect various sites. This experience has allowed me to apply theoretical knowledge to real-world scenarios, honing my ability to recognise potential hazards and recommend appropriate safety measures.



WHAT IS THE MOST EXCITING PROJECT YOU HAVE WORKED ON?

The most exciting project I have worked on has been the Office Working Environment Project that I coordinated and led. The primary objective of this project was to conduct a thorough and rigorous assessment of the existing working conditions within a specified office building on the Parliamentary Estate. Using a qualitative survey of staff, it identified areas in need of improvement and it targeted interventions that foster a safer, more ergonomic, and comfortable workplace. I was able to showcase the skills and knowledge that I have developed during my apprenticeship throughout the project whilst also pushing myself to develop leadership skills. The result of the project was the reduction of health concerns for the building users and improved satisfaction.
