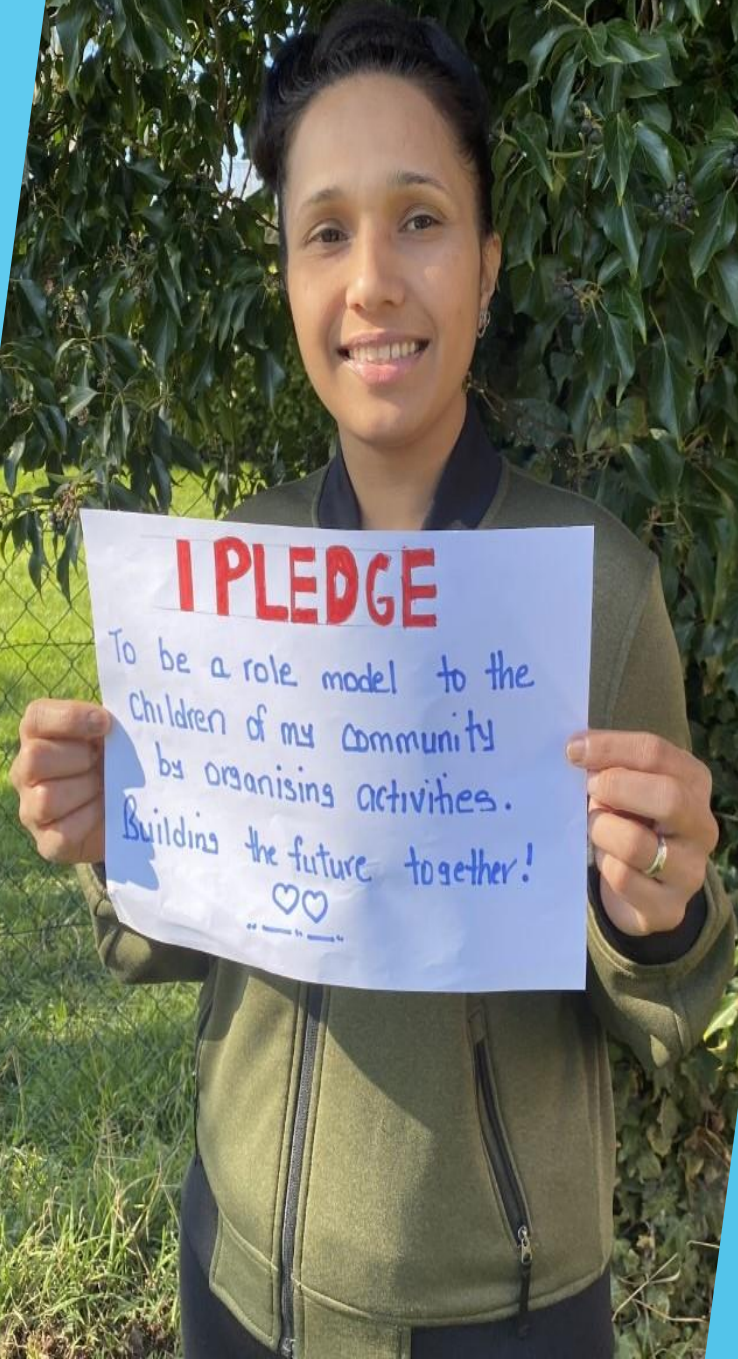
Senior Aircraftwoman Rosetta Norbert Logistics Chef
