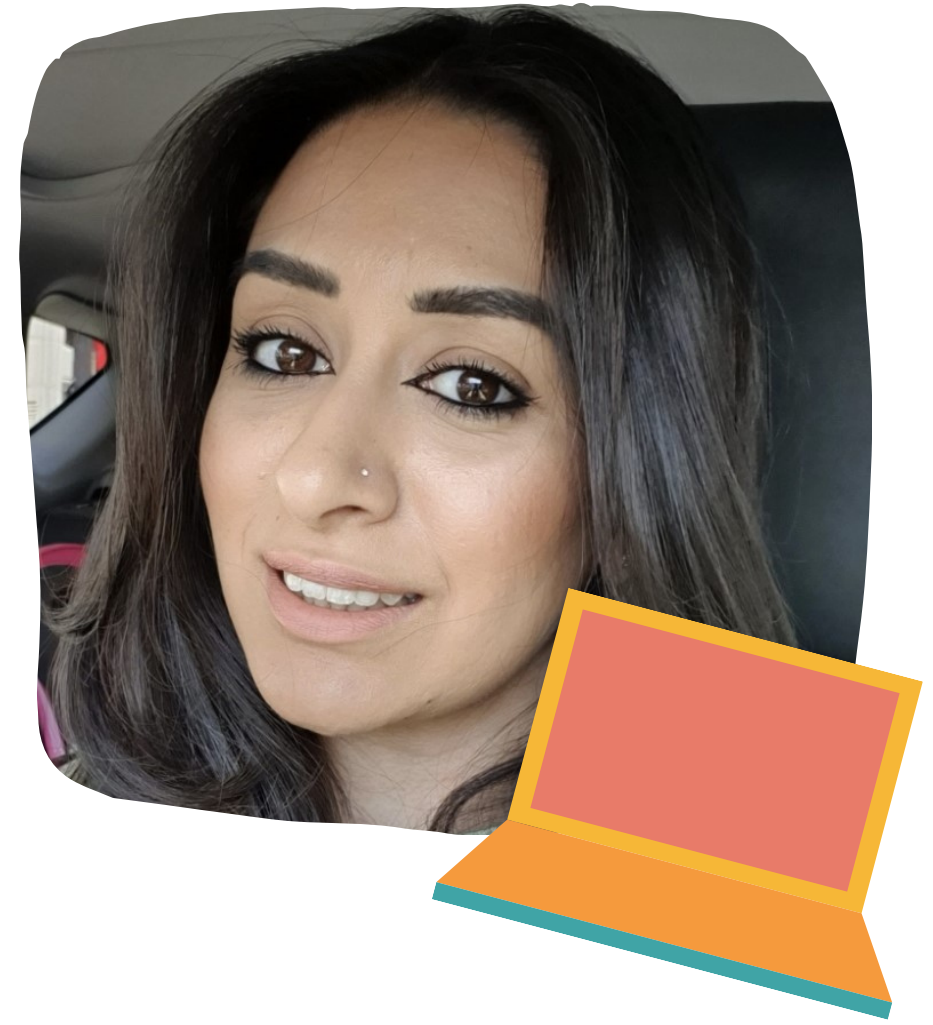
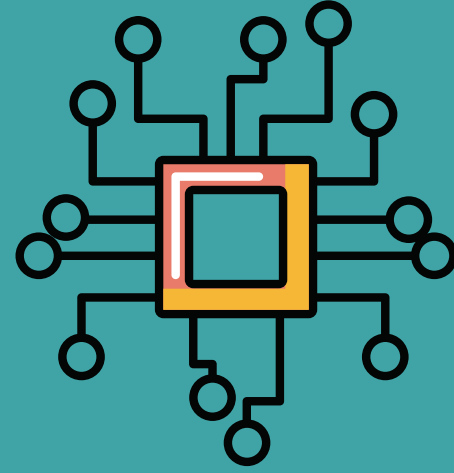


NADIA RASHAD
