## APPRENTICESHIPS - PUTTING ON A CONCERT

**Main activity**

- Using the accompanying PowerPoint, talk to students about the different roles that it takes to put on a concert. Please note you can change the image or add more images as relevant to your class or what you are currently studying.
- Then show the students how to search for apprenticeships on the Institute for Apprenticeships and Technical Education website <https://www.instituteforapprenticeships.org/apprenticeship-standards/>
- Ask students to see how many different apprenticeships they can find that could have helped to made the concert happen. Encourage them to think outside the box!

**Reflection task**

- Ask students if they would consider working in the music industry and which apprenticeship they think would be good to do.
