### Activity

Seek to promote the wellbeing and flourishing, spiritual, emotional and (where appropriate) physical, of both individuals and communities.

Compliance and risk officer (level 3)

Work with children, young people and families, including carers, to achieve positive and sustainable change in their lives.

Solicitor (level 7)

Make the education of their pupils their first concern and work with parents/guardians in the best interests of their pupils.

Peer worker (level 3)

Require sound ethical standards, together with good communication and influencing skills, as there can be differences of opinion on the appropriate action to take.

Church minister (level 6)

Identify and address data biases, and handle private data ethically and appropriately, complying with (inter)national privacy regulations.

Social worker (level 6)

Assess, plan, implement and evaluate complex situations, which requires an ability to critically reflect and make decisions within a clear professional code of ethics.

Teacher (level 6)

Hold conversations that include discussing issues of mutuality and equality, ethical dilemmas and when to challenge practices that exert power and control and restrict the choice of individuals.

Children, young people & families practitioner (level 4)

Act ethically, with professionalism and judgement to give advice to clients.
