How do I find a Formula 1 apprenticeship?

Apprenticeships with Formula 1 teams are incredibly competitive, with lots of people applying for a limited number of positions, so to give yourself the best chance, you could:



Visit the websites of the teams offering apprenticeships and find out when they are recruiting and what they require.



Find out if there are any recruitment events or activities you could take part in.



Do some research into smaller businesses who work with Formula 1 or as part of their supply chain and see if they offer apprenticeships.



Make sure you have a CV and covering letter ready. >>>
