## A HIGHER TECHNICAL QUALIFICATION COULD BE THE PERFECT OPTION


- Higher Technical Qualifications (HTQs) are level 4 and 5 qualifications you can take after a level 3 qualification such as A-levels, a BTEC or a T Level.
- They are one or two-year courses, so shorter and cheaper than a full degree.
- They have been approved by employers as teaching the skills they want.
- HTQs are flexible and can be studied full or part-time.
