

Supporting students onto level 4 and 5 courses



If you have students who:

- want to continue studying in a classroom environment with practical assignments, but don't want to do a full degree or haven't secured a place.
- want an apprenticeship, but haven't secured one yet.
- are looking for a course that could lead on to a full degree, apprenticeship or employment.
- want to get a job-focused qualification that teaches the skills employers want.

A Higher Technical Qualification could be the perfect option

What to say to students about HTQs:

HTQs are level 4 or 5 courses that you can do after a level 3 qualification like A-levels, T Levels or BTECs.

HTQs are one or two-year courses that could be the perfect next step to lead to the job, apprenticeship or further study you are hoping for.

HTQs are approved by employers as delivering the skills they want, so they are a really strong qualification to have on your CV.

HTQs are really flexible; you can study full or part-time alongside working if you want.

As HTQs only take one or two years, they cost less than doing a full degree and you can access student loans and other funding for HTQs, the same as for a full degree.

You can start an HTQ in September, or sometimes in January too, if you aren't ready to decide yet.

HTQs are a great option if you don't want to commit to a three-year degree.

You can study HTQs at universities, colleges, Institutes of Technology and independent training providers, so they are really flexible.

If you know which sector you want to specialise in, an HTQ would be perfect as they are job-focused.
